- If you would like to bring something to be served at fellowship hour, that is also welcome. It helps for the office to know a week ahead so that plans can be made accordingly.

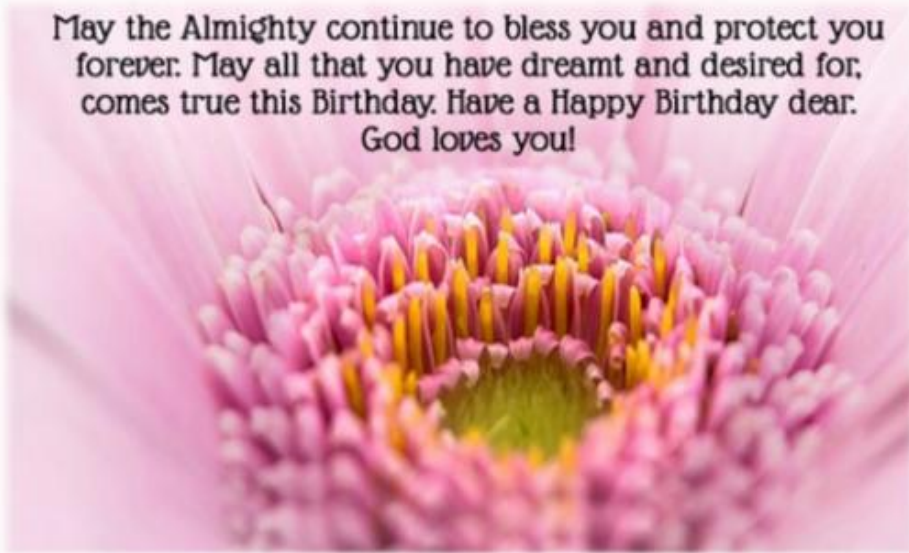


- If you would like to be reimbursed for expenses, be sure to save your receipts. You can give these to Joan Deppa or Andrew McTyre.
